<u>Key Labourers:</u> Ideal for Someone who is Interested in Landscaping and helping with daily cultural practices on the course. **(February/March start)**

In this role you will demonstrate the ability to grasp tasks after being shown and progress with a keen eye for detail. Typical Duties could include; setting the courses up for daily play, operating equipment, fertilizing with push spreaders and tractor mounted, hand watering dry areas as required, communicating with leadership on areas to address, patching thin/weak areas of turf, etc.. This position can be seasonal or grow into year-round work with the right candidate.

Equipment Operators: Ideal for someone looking for seasonal work with the ability to play golf. **(March start)**

Our Equipment Operators work on a 4 and 5 day schedule. During the shoulder seasons we work Monday-Friday (Feb-April) (Sept-Dec) and during our prime season we can accommodate a 4-day schedule if desired. (Mon/Tue and Thur/Fri). Cutting Rough, Fairways, Tees or Greens. Other odd jobs when not cutting would include Leaf/Debris Cleanup, Edging Yardage Markers, Cart Path Edging and Cleaning, etc..... All experience levels are welcome as we will train. Early morning starts allow you to see the sunrise each day and an early end time allows you to still enjoy the afternoon. Typical start times in Spring are 6am, moving to 5am in prime season before moving back to 6am in the Fall. Depending on Tournament Schedule we have the odd earlier start.

Summer Staff: Ideal for Students. (May/June start)

Starting Late April or Early May, we are flexible around school schedules. Duties include cutting greens with walk mowers, raking sand traps, trimming bunkers and detail areas around the property and assisting with Cultural Practices throughout the season. Early morning starts, typical shift is 5am-1pm Monday – Friday with a paid 30 min lunch break. (We are flexible with the days you work and can discuss all options) Weekend work in the Spring and Fall is also an option. All training provided, just bring your own Green Patch footwear and we will get you out on the course.







Weekend Staff: Ideal for Someone looking for a couple shifts a week. **(February/March start)**

Our Weekend Staff get the Golf Courses ready for play in a fast past environment. With weekends being one of our busiest times, we start earlier then normal. A typical summer shift will be 4:30am-12:30pm with a paid 30min lunch. We are flexible and can accommodate shorter shifts to work with your schedule. Duties include Greens Mowing with walk behind mowers, Bunker Raking with hand rakes and machines, Debris removal with Backpack blowers along with any other tasks that might need completing before Golfers get on the course.

Greeter: Ideal for someone looking for light duty course work and customer service. **(Anytime start)**

The Greeter position is one that would be the first person golfers see when they arrive to Northview. A typical shift would be 4 or 5 hours in the greeter booth, followed by caring for on course presentations areas.

The Greeter duties include making initial contact with our customers and inquiring about their day, providing any directions, or answering questions they might. The Utility duties include maintaining all presentation areas on course and around our Clubhouse and Driving Range. Ensuring on course furniture is clean and in good condition. Maintaining Par 3 tee decks, such as removal of tees and filling divots.
